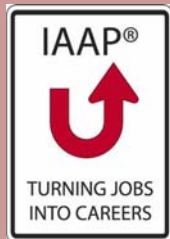

TREASURER'S REPORT:

Web Site

Dream host would cost \$36 web hosting plus \$12/yr to renew domain. The current cost is \$108 plus DNS \$25 (domain name). We are paying \$37.50/yr now to renew.

Lynda Bennett CPS will have Cory added as an Administrator on the Midohio server. Cory will verify all costs before proceeding.

Sharon Cole moved that Cory be added as Administrator on our behalf for Midohio and change our server to Dream host. Jean Noterman seconded. Motion carried.

Here are a few secretly kept tips:
